Chairman's Report

Planning & Public Realm

Nigel Hughes provided an update on key planning activity in the area, including 63-65 Curzon
 Street and Leconfield house which are being reviewed by MNF P&PRC.

The River Tyburn

• Paul O'Grady gave an update on The River Tyburn with a coordinated and flexible approach agreed between areas. Further details are to be shared.

CIL

- Eric Scots-Knight shared updated CIL allocations. Work is continuing with WCC to finalise application and budget for Aldford Gardens.
- Members encouraged transparency of how allocated CIL is spent and increased focus in North and South Mayfair.
- Members are prompted to interact with Mayfair Green Routes consultation which is currently ongoing.

Communications incl. Park Lane

- Edward Watts shared plans for membership review and encouraged new recruitment of members.
- Update on the future of the Curzon which requires community support.
- MNF submitted a negative response to TfL consultation on Park Lane cycle lane and are awaiting outcome.

AOB
